June Meeting Highlights

President, David Podurgiel welcomed members in attendance. Twenty-seven members registered for the meeting. He gave special welcome to Dessa McCurdy of McCutcheon who was attending her first meeting and to Josh Maynard and Christopher Clark of AMG Resources who have expressed interest in becoming new members. AMG handles processing and trading of scrap. Josh and Christopher attended as guests of Ingram Barge.

President Podurgiel presented the Navigation Report. Discussion included the complications caused by the current on-going low water event; close to critical. Low water affects both locks and navigation and care must be taken. The USACE, National Weather and our Navigational Committee have worked closely during this event to keep mariners informed of complications. A written Navigation Report was not available.

Scott Harshman of PPC provided the Legislative Report. He advised PPC has requested additional IWTF funding to complete the Montgomery Lock project. He reports the House has added verbage to a bill toward this goal. PPC received 26 applications for the Small Grants program totaling approximately \$200K with a budget of only \$70K. Recipients will be announced in July. He thanked Carole Ann Krelow, Executive Director who is retiring, for her work with PPC and the WAP.

LTJG Mills advised dialing 911 who are very effective in forwarding emergency information to one of the available agencies, Pittsburgh Fire River Rescue and PA Fish & Boat. Mills then presented a plaque and Challenge Coin to Carole Ann Krelow, Executive Director, thanking her for the good work she has done for the WAP and the USCG during her term.

Of note, the current dry spell has caused low water conditions predicting rainfall, although it may be "scattered" with hit and miss conditions. Predicted El Nino conditions will bring normal to below normal temperatures, advising even with normal rainfall throughout the balance of the year, our precipitation accumulation may stay below normal.
