<u>Legislative Committee & Port of Pittsburgh Commission Report – Scott Harshman (Port of Pittsburgh), Chair;</u> Legislative Committee: Scott Harshman, Pat Kelly, and George Petrus

LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE:

1. Priorities:

- Continue to support Upper Ohio River Navigation System & Lower Mon Projects
- Oppose additional taxation, tolling, and lockage fees
- Fully utilize and draw down funding from the Inland Waterways Trust Fund
- Support initiative that navigation projects identified as "funded to completion" with Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) funding should continue to be 100% funded from the General Treasury -- not cost-shared -- consistent with Congressional intent.

2. Congressional Appropriations

- Request submitted to Congress for additional funding needed for the Lower Mon Project
- US House Appropriations Committee approved their bill on June 22 and the US Senate Appropriations Committee passed their bill on July 20
- 3. Water Resources Development Act of 2024

4. PA State Budget

- \$45.4 billion budget package signed into law August 3
 - Boosts education funding by over \$700 million a more than 8% increase over last year's budget
 - 11% funding increase for the Department of Environmental Protection to clear permitting backlogs and add staff for administrative work
 - Increases access to Apprenticeships & Vocational and Technical Education
